The building and the faces have changed, but having been on both sides of the fence at LaSalle I have to say that I have enjoyed both sides equally as well.



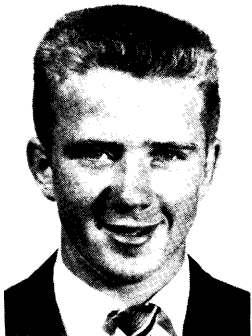
